

Daniel and The Revelation by Uriah Smith (pp. 114-5) Chap. 7 – The Struggle for World Dominion The Son of Man Receives His Kingdom.--The scene here described is not the second coming of Christ to this earth, for the Ancient of days is not on this earth, and the coming here spoken of is to the Ancient of days. There, in the presence of the Father, dominion, and glory, and a kingdom are given to the Son of man. Christ receives His kingdom before His return to this earth. (See Luke 19:10-12.) Therefore, this is a scene which takes place in heaven, and is closely connected with that brought to view in verses 9 and 10. Christ receives His kingdom at the close of His priestly work in the sanctuary.




Daniel and The Revelation by Uriah Smith (pg. 115) Chap. 7 – The Struggle for World Dominion


